Delegate Survey 2023 Overview



February 2024

Background

The Delegate Survey was conducted between May and October 2023.

Data was collected at major congresses across various disciplines held in Helsinki, with a total of 745 responses received from residents of more than 60 countries. The target group of the study consisted of non-resident international congress delegates in Helsinki.

The Delegate Survey is annually conducted study to enhance our understanding of our customers by examining how international congress visitors perceive Helsinki. This aims to improve our customer work, allowing us to more efficiently respond to future needs and address any possible deficiencies.

Nearly half of the delegates travel with companions.

Helsinki is widely regarded as an excellent destination for congress events by the delegates.

Nearly all delegates express great satisfaction with Helsinki, the host city. Most delegates chose to stay in Helsinki for their entire trip to Finland, possibly extending their visit by up to two extra nights.

The delegates consider Finland an appealing option for their future holidays.


Most delegates perceive Helsinki as a sustainable destination and used eco-friendly transport.


Residence country of the respondents

Country of Residence (N=745)





More than half of the respondents (59%) travel without accompanying






Majority (76%) of the respondents are visiting Finland for the first time




Additional nights outside the event staying *in* Helsinki (N=745)



Helsinki Partners Majority (88%) of the respondents stay in the host city maxium 2 additional nights


Additional nights outside the event staying *outside* Helsinki (N=745)


Overall satisfaction with the host city Helsinki (N=741)


Was this event of a greater professional value to you because it was held in Helsinki? (N=745)

Helsinki as a sustainable destination (N=745)


457 respondents were able to get around the city in an environmentally friendly way (eg. walking, by bike, using public transport).

295 respondents of 745 find Helsinki as safe and equal to all (e.g. accessibility, LGBTQI+, religion).
